## Granville to St Marys track maintenance

From Friday 31 March to Monday 3 April 2023

### What we're doing

Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works between Granville and St Marys from Friday 31 March to Monday 3 April.

Sydney Metro works are continuing at Westmead Station. Upcoming work will include:

- Removal of redundant cables
- Removal of poles and conductors requiring temporary road closures on Alexandra Avenue and Park Parade
- Installation of cable containment and low voltage equipment work
- Minor finishing and rectification work.

Sydney Metro will undertake investigations, inspections, utility work and other activities within the rail corridor at or near St Marys Station, to prepare for the construction of Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport and the new footbridge.

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Ballast cleaning at Doonside
- Bridge renewal at Bridge Road Overbridge, Westmead
- Contact wire renewal at Toongabbie
- Points Machine upgrade at Westmead
- Routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Doonside
- Track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Track reconditioning at Harris Park
- Track resurfacing, tamping and rail grinding activities
- Vegetation maintenance, litter and graffiti removal.

### How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 11pm Friday 31 March until 2am Monday 3 April.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Final (finishing) works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

#### Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
