Great Western Highway closed at Mount Victoria for essential maintenance work on Monday, 18 September

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on the Great Western Highway near Mount Victoria.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work which includes realigning temporary barriers, line marking and vegetation and drainage maintenance. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

To minimise disruption to traffic, the work will take place at night and will be carried out on **Monday 18 September** from **8.00pm** to **5am**. The work is expected to take **one night** to complete, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work. We will aim to complete noisier activities before **midnight** and direct lighting away from residences where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

For the safety of motorists and workers the Great Western Highway will be closed in both directions between Mount Victoria and Lithgow. A detour via Chifley Road and Darling Causeway will be in place for all through traffic during this time.

Access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and residents to the closure points at the top and bottom gantry at Victoria Pass.

Motorists are advised to allow an additional 5 minutes travel time for the detour.
