Heathcote Road Upgrade

October 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cabrogal people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Major work is continuing on the Heathcote Road Upgrade that will help reduce congestion, improve road safety and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

What work are we doing in October?

Our work over the next six weeks includes ongoing utility adjustments:

- between Infantry Parade and The Avenue, potholing, trenching and relocation of watermains and street lights
- Heathcote Road utility crossing works to enable potable water relocation for upgraded watermains
- affected customers will be notified of any planned disruptions or outages by utility providers.

Ongoing work in October also includes:

- Infantry Parade to The Avenue, removal of existing asphalt, concrete pavement, medians, islands and kerbs
- Macarthur Drive roundabout enabling works in preparation for the intersection upgrade
- Heathcote Road construction of temporary pavements and line-marking at various locations
- T8 Airport and South Line construction of a retaining wall and bridge
- Harris Creek eastbound bridge piling works
- Williams Creek eastbound bridge construction

- The Avenue and Heathcote Road excavation and construction of a retaining wall
- Infantry Parade to The Avenue barrier installation and asphalting
- installation of stormwater drainage and existing stormwater relining. Where possible work will be undertaken during the day without disruption to traffic, however some drainage lines will require night works with partial lane closures
- in the coming weeks subsoil drainage installation beneath future kerbing will start
- MacArthur Drive and Heathcote Road reconstruction works during weekend closures.

Our work schedule

Our standard work hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.

Out of hours work

Night work will be required on various occasions throughout October 2023, weather permitting.

Work will include

- utility and barrier relocation
- line marking,
- installation of stormwater drainage
- existing stormwater relining and asphalting.

We will work over five-night shifts per week but only on **two consecutive nights in the same area,** weather permitting.

Construction hours are between 6pm and 7am,

How this work will affect you

To minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to workers and road users, we need to carry out construction work at night and on weekends.

The out of hours work will be noisy at times, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by:

- carrying out noisier work before midnight where
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- directing lights away from properties where

Traffic disruptions are likely due to partial lane closures at night for the installation of stormwater drainage, with traffic controllers in place to assist motorists.

Equipment used may include:

generators, excavators, pilling rig, soil nail drill rig, rollers, street sweeper, jackhammer, trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, powered hand tools, underbore machines, concrete cutter, water cart, and lighting towers.

Ertech celebrates a significant milestone

Over the weekend of 16-17 September, Ertech's dedicated team reached a significant project milestone with the successful installation of eight concrete girders for the new single-span bridge over the electrified rail line.

The complex lift of eight 30-meter-long girders over rail involved weeks of meticulous planning to ensure a safe, efficient operation with minimal disruption to rail and road commuters.

Borger Cranes was engaged to undertake the lift and utilised two smaller cranes in a dual lift operation to feed the girders to the 750t crane for placement.At around 4.30am on Saturday the first girder rose gracefully into the sky with the final girder expertly positioned just before 2 p.m.
