

Heathcote Road Bridge upgrade

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.



An additional bridge has been built parallel to the existing bridge over Woronora River, providing safety and traffic benefits to this critical link between Greater Sydney and Wollongong.

The new bridge opened to traffic in March 2023, under a temporary arrangement to allow maintenance work to be carried out on the original bridge. Work is progressing well, with the project on track for completion in mid-2023.

What work are we doing?

Remaining work on the project includes:

- Installing signage and landscaping
- Completing bridge median barrier work
- Placing the final pavement layer and completing line marking

Traffic changes

In mid-June both bridges will open to traffic with

eastbound traffic using one lane on the original bridge and westbound traffic using one lane on the new bridge. During this time, work will still occur on the median barriers between the two bridges. Once work on the central median is complete, both the eastbound and westbound lanes will be complete and provide two-metrewide shoulders.

Traffic changes will be in place on Heathcote Road while work is being carried out including temporary lane and shoulder closures, intermittent stop/slow traffic control and reduced speed limits.

There will continue to be **full weeknight closures** of Heathcote Road between **9pm and 5am**, and **one remaining weekend closure** in mid-2023, for pavement work.

During full closures of Heathcote Road, a detour will be in place between New Illawarra Road and Princes Highway.

We will keep the community informed ahead of road closures, through our website and electronic message boards.
