Night work on Hexham Bridge, Hexham from Monday 4 September

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work to ensure safe and reliable operation of Hexham Bridge.

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes inspecting, testing and servicing the lift span systems, as well as general routine bridge maintenance.

We will be working at night between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Thursday** and expect to complete the work in **four nights**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

The southbound bridge will be closed during the work. All traffic will be diverted onto the northbound bridge, which will operate with one lane in each direction.

A 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to 10 minutes extra travel time during this work.

The opening span will not open to marine traffic while the work is carried out.

The pedestrian footpath will be closed while the work is carried out. Traffic control will be on site to safely escort pedestrians across the bridge while the footpath is closed.
