Homebush to Strathfield Signalling Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

April and May 2023

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

This project will upgrade the signalling infrastructure inside the rail corridor between Homebush and Strathfield to improve train movements through the stations.

What work are we doing?

Investigation work is nearing completion and in the coming weeks we will start main construction on the Homebush to Strathfield Signalling Upgrade.

In April and May we will:

- complete any outstanding investigation work. This involves locating existing underground services and confirming ground conditions
- start installation of new signalling, overhead wiring and electrical infrastructure.

Where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor.

To facilitate the work, we will use the existing site compound on Columbia Lane and establish a temporary site compound on Albert Street as shown overleaf. The site compounds will be used for storage of equipment and materials, worker parking and pre-start work meetings.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Some work will take place outside of these hours from:

- 10pm Tuesday 18 April to 5am Wednesday 19 April 2023
- 10pm Wednesday 19 April to 5am Thursday 20 April 2023
- 10pm Friday 28 April to 2am Monday 1 May 2023
- 10am Friday 19 May to 2am Monday 22 May 2023.

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling work outside of standard construction hours enables us to complete essential work safely.

Temporary parking changes on The Crescent, Homebush

Up to **15 parking spaces** will be temporarily reserved near the rail access gate on The Crescent near the intersection with Homebush Road. The parking changes will be in place to facilitate construction activities from:

- 7am Thursday 27 April to 2am Monday 1 May
- 7am Thursday 18 May to 2am Monday 22 May

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your patience.
