# Homebush to Strathfield Signalling Upgrade

## More Trains, More Services

September and October 2023

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wangal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers.

This project will upgrade the infrastructure inside the rail corridor between Homebush and Strathfield to improve train movements through the stations.

## What work are we doing?

In the coming months we will construct two new footings inside the rail corridor that will serve as the foundation for new overhead wiring infrastructure. The work will involve excavation and concreting work.

We will also undertake electrical work and strengthen existing overhead wiring structures.

## Where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor and at the substation on Columbia Lane, Homebush.

We will use the site compound on Columbia Lane and establish a temporary site compound inside the carpark on Parnell Street. These will be used for deliveries, storage of equipment and materials, worker facilities, parking and briefings.

## When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am** and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Some work will take place outside of these hours from:

• 10pm Friday 8 September to 2am Monday 11

September 2023

- 10pm Friday 13 October to 2am Monday 16 October 2023
- 10pm Friday 27 October to 2am Monday 30 October 2023.

For safety reasons, this work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running.

## Temporary parking changes

The following parking changes will be in place to facilitate construction activities. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause.

#### Parnell Street, Strathfield

The carpark on Parnell Street (east of The Boulevarde) will be closed from:

- 12am Friday 8 September to 11pm Sunday 10 September 2023
- 12am Friday 13 October to 11pm Sunday 15 October 2023.

#### The Crescent, Strathfield/Homebush

We will temporarily remove **up to 20 parking spaces** near the intersection with Homebush Road from:

- 7am Thursday 7 September to 2am Monday 11 September 2023
- 7am Thursday 12 October to 2am Monday 16 October 2023.

Sydney Trains may also remove parking along The Crescent and Parnell Street.
