Out of hours work along Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road, Badgerys Creek

The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out night work over **21 night shifts** between **Monday 3 July 2023** and **Monday 31 July 2023** along Elizabeth Drive, west of Badgerys Creek Road in Badgerys Creek and Luddenham Road, Luddenham.

During this period, we will:

- repair, maintain, install, remove and adjust road pavement, barriers, line marking, signage and road furniture as required
- complete utilities work across Elizabeth Drive under traffic control conditions
- deliver fill materials to the construction site on Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road
- install retaining wall panels adjacent to Elizabeth Drive
- pour concrete foundations and bridge elements
- prepare for crane mobilisation
- deliver, use and remove oversized equipment when needed, including delivery and unloading of large concrete beams.

The works need to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and road users and to minimise traffic disruption.

We will also continue bridge works across Luddenham Road, Luddenham and either side of Elizabeth Drive,

Badgerys Creek during the day. Traffic control will be in place during the work to manage the construction and road traffic across the construction intersection on Luddenham Road.

Our work schedule

Our night work hours are between 6pm and 7am, Monday to Saturday morning. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week, in the same location. Our normal work hours are between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and between 8am and 6pm on Saturdays. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

What equipment will be used?

During the night work we may use lighting towers, excavators, skid steers, dump trucks, trucks, compactors, light and heavy vehicles, hand powered tools, a large crawler crane, small cranes and wheeled excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete pumps, water carts, sweepers, milling machines and asphalt pavers, water blasters for line marking removal, and line marking trucks.

When we work at night and on the road we will have traffic control in place.

What will this mean for you?

During night work, you may see increased activities in the area. Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities earlier in the night before **midnight**, where possible, and turning off equipment and machinery when not in use.



We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in the same week at the same location.

Managing our impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone and traffic are safe while the equipment is used, delivered and removed.
