

# Mona Vale Road East Upgrade

Transport for NSW | July 2023

Transport is upgrading Mona Vale Road between Manor Road, Ingleside and Foley Street, Mona Vale, from two lanes to four lanes to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety.

## Manor Road to Foley Street

We will be working outside of standard work hours on Mona Vale Road between Manor Road and Foley Street from **8pm to 6am Saturday 1 July to Monday 31 July 2023**, weather permitting.

Please note, in line with our environmental license, we will not work more than two consecutive nights and no more than three nights each week.

Our work will include:

- Road maintenance, gate adjustments, barrier movements, line marking, and plant delivery/pick up along the project alignment.
- Lifting and installation of the new fauna bridge overpass supports on Mona Vale Road during the one-day road closure.
- Asphaltting, kerbing work, stormwater installation and median works between Daydream Street and Foley Street east.
- Asphaltting work in Samuel Street.
- Traffic realignment, drainage and kerb work on Mona Vale Road at Manor Road and Lane Cove Road.
- Traffic realignment of Mona Vale Road from Lane Cove Road to Foley Street.
- Constructing the pavement and medians on Mona Vale Road.
- Constructing Ponderosa Parade intersection.
- Installing stormwater drainage at Ponderosa Parade and Mona Vale Road.

## Mona Vale Road night lane closure

There will be a partial night lane closure of Mona Vale Road from Manor Road to

Ponderosa Parade on **Monday 10 July** and a full lane closure on **Tuesday 11 July from 10:30pm to 5am.**

These closures of Mona Vale Road over **two nights** will enable us to minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to the workers and motorists during the lifting and installation of the new fauna overpass bridge supports.

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users.

This work will be weather dependent and if it does not occur on these nights, we will look to undertake the work the following week.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

A drone will be used each month to take progress photos and assist with survey work within the project area.

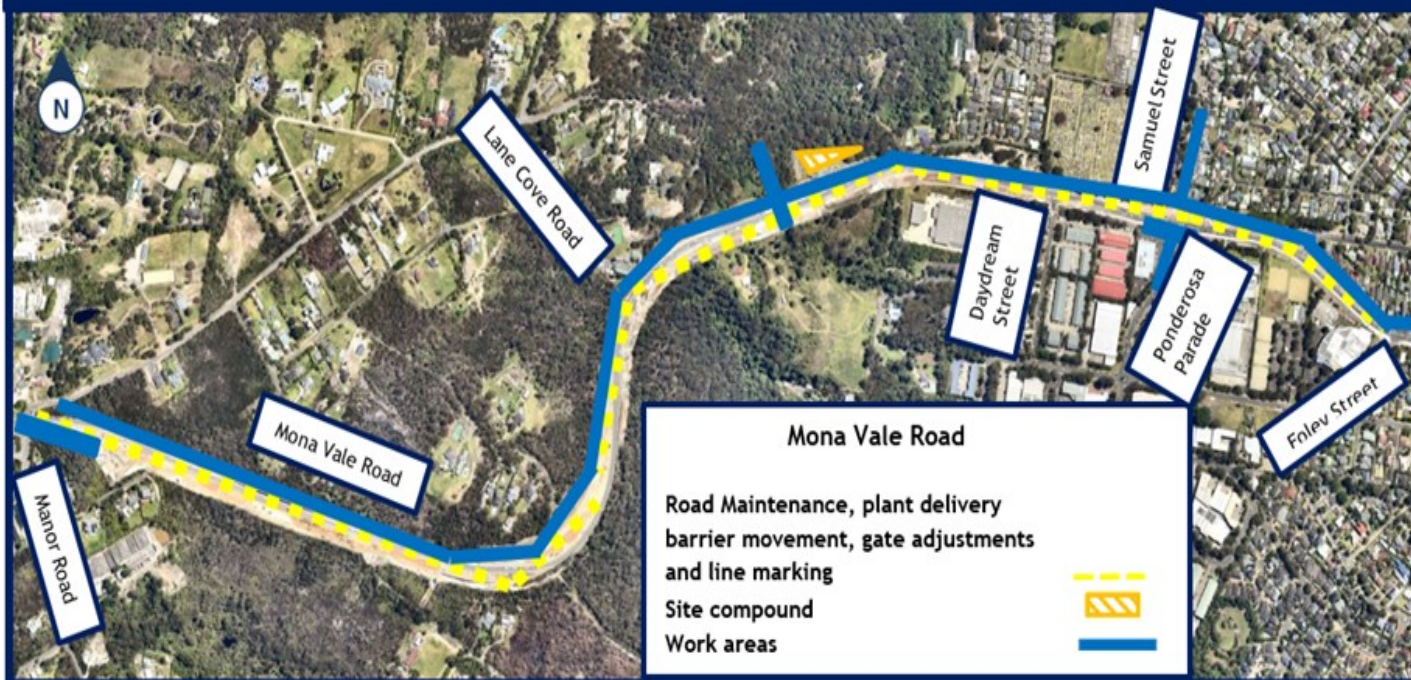
## How will our work impact you?

During this out of hours work, machinery and equipment used may include tipper trucks, large trucks, backhoes, elevated work platforms, light vehicles, lighting towers, saw cutting machines, franna, line markers, excavators and paving machines. This work will be noisy. We will direct any lighting away from residential properties and turn off machinery when not in use.

The project team will contact directly impacted residents eligible for respite in advance of the works.

If our work is delayed, we will notify you in advance of the new dates.
