# Power outage for tree clearing

## Generators in place from 16 July to 19 July

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Medlow Bath Upgrade, with tree clearing near high voltage power lines.

Due to windy weather during the recent planned power outage, we were unable to finish the tree clearing work near high voltage power lines on Bellevue Crescent.

### How will the work affect you?

To allow us to complete this work, there will be another planned power outage from Sunday 16 July to Wednesday 19 July.

During the outage, two generators will be placed on Delmonte Avenue to supply power to impacted local properties. Generator noise blankets will be double-layered and extended above the height of both generator units to help mitigate noise impacts.

Using generators will allow us to do the work without impacting residents with full day power outages.

## Traffic changes

Traffic control may be in place where necessary, with the access road between Bellevue Crescent and the service station restricted to residents only.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
