The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work to prepare for the upgrade at Medlow Bath, between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent.

What work are we doing?

- Temporary traffic lights are being installed on the Great Western Highway to facilitate a safer crossing on the Great Western Highway for school pedestrians
- They will be in use during the operation of the temporary school bus stops on the highway.

When and where we'll be working

Temporary traffic lights will be in use from **17 July for up to three weeks during school bus times**, at the existing traffic refuge island on the Great Western Highway.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of the temporary traffic lights and pedestrian detour during this time.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Temporary traffic lights installed on the Great Western Highway for school pedestrians accessing bus routes 698 and 8710

- Traffic controllers will be at the lights to assist school pedestrians
- Maintained access for pedestrians along Railway Parade, to Medlow Park and the railway station.

Pedestrians including school children should follow traffic control instructions for safety.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Removing the temporary traffic lights when not in use outside of school peak times
- Providing delineation for pedestrians along Railway Parade.

We understand that this work will generate some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.

Traffic Impacts

Temporary traffic lights and traffic controllers will be in place to help school pedestrians safely cross the Great Western Highway.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.
