Upcoming utility work and deliveries - La Perouse

August 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal and Bidjigal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

What work are we doing?

Key upcoming work activities at La Perouse include:

- From **Monday 14 August** we will start work to connect the water supply to the future La Perouse Wharf. This work is due to be completed by late-September.
- Following this, we will start work to connect the electrical services. This work will take around two weeks to complete.
- We have staged these utility works to maintain access for people walking and driving.

We will work during normal daytime hours **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**.

- From **late August**, we will deliver large equipment and wharf components to our site. Some of these will be delivered **during the night** to meet road safety requirements.

Water connection work

- The work area is shown in green on the map over the page.
- We will be digging into the road and footpath to access the watermain.
- We will install a new water pipe from the roundabout along the grass on the Museum side of Anzac Parade and across the road.

You may notice:

- Fencing around the grassed area where we are working
- A variety of equipment including excavators, vacuum excavator trucks, and trucks carrying spoil and ground material
- We will temporarily remove three parking spaces for up to three days.

Electrical connection work

- The work area is shown in blue on the map over the page.
- We will open a series of 'pits' along the footpath to connect to the power network.

You may notice:

- A variety of equipment including vacuum excavators, small compaction and equipment, and material delivery trucks.
- We will temporarily remove two parking spaces to complete this work.

Managing our impacts

- We will contact you if there are any temporary impacts to your electrical or water supply.
- We may generate noise during these water and electrical works. We will carry out vibration and noise monitoring in line with the approved Noise and Vibration Management Plan.
- We will maintain traffic and pedestrian access during the work.
- We will reinstate all areas once work is complete.
- We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and thank you for your patience while we complete this important work.
- All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.



Deliveries

We need to transport a large crane and two pre-cast concrete pieces to the site. This will be done at night to comply with oversized load requirements.

The crane is currently planned to be delivered to site between **4am and 5am on Tuesday 29 August 2023**.

The crane will remain on site for approximately five months.

We will also be delivering other pre-cast items during normal work hours. You may notice a higher volume of trucks entering and exiting the site.

You may experience short wait times if you are walking or driving, and hear noise from deliveries as they travel to and from site and are safely unloaded.

Other work in the area
