What work are we doing?

Upcoming work activities at La Perouse include:

- From Monday 28 August we will start excavating rock to prepare for installation of the new landside wharf approach structure (called an abutment).
- The approach structure will connect the landside pathway to the new wharf.
- The rock excavation work will take up to two weeks to complete.
- We will work during normal daytime hours **7am** to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.
- A reminder that from late August we will deliver large equipment and wharf components to our site. Some of these will be delivered during the night to meet road safety requirements.

All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

Rock excavation works

- We will be working inside our main construction site at La Perouse.
- We will use machinery such as rock saws and road saws to cut into the rock, and excavators with different attachments to hammer and break the rock apart.
- The rock pieces will be loaded onto trucks and removed from site.
- At times, noise levels may be higher than what you may have previously experienced.

Reducing our impacts

We will:

- provide breaks throughout the rock hammering work
- spray water on the work areas to control dust
- carry out the work as outlined in the **Construction Heritage Management Plan**
- closely monitor the vibration and noise impacts of this activity.
