The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading King Georges Road between Stoney Creek Road, Beverly Hills and Forest Road, Hurstville to improve safety, reduce congestion and improve journey times for road users.

- Fencing for safety and security
- Installing noise blankets, where possible
- Reducing noise, where possible
- Completing noisier activities like saw-cutting and jackhammering by midnight, where possible.

What work are we doing?

From **Monday 8 January 2024**, access to George Street from King Georges Road will be closed whilst we construct new road pavement, pedestrian footpath and a speed hump.

Clarence Street, between King Georges Road and Cambridge Street, will remain closed until **January 2024**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Residential access will be maintained via Cambridge Street only during these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Further information about the progress of these works will be communicated in the second week of January.

Our day work hours are **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, Saturday 8am to 1pm** and our night work hours are **Sunday to Friday 8pm to 6am**. We will work a maximum of five nights a week.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

Asbestos monitoring

As the project progresses, asbestos may be discovered in the ground within the project area. If asbestos is identified, we will implement our Asbestos Management Plan, which details safe work practices, and ensures that all potential asbestos removal works are managed to strict Environment Protection Authority requirements.

Traffic changes

During our works, there will be an increase in traffic movements in and around the local streets, with temporary traffic changes and local road closures in place to ensure the work zone is safe.
