Canterbury Road and King Georges Road intersection upgrade complete

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Daruk and Eora people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The upgrade of Canterbury Road and King Georges Road intersection in Wiley Park is now complete.

Canterbury Road has been widened to provide additional right turn lanes on to King Georges Road in both directions.

What has the project delivered?

This project was funded from a \$240 million investment by Australian and State Governments to fast-track 11 congestion busting projects.

Work commenced in November 2020 and has now been completed with road users benefiting by making the following improvements:

- Widened Canterbury Road on the eastern and western approaches to provide additional right turn lanes to King Georges Road.
- Changed the existing dual left turn signalised slip lanes on Canterbury Road for vehicles turning into King Georges Road to a single give way slip lane.
- Realigned the left turn slip lanes on Canterbury Road in both directions to provide better vision for motorists preparing to turn left.

- Adjusted the existing entrance into Wiley Park and constructed a retaining wall on the revised road boundary.
- Relocated existing impacted underground/overhead utilities and equipment, including an existing speed camera on the Canterbury Road.
- New pavement where required.

What are the benefits?

The project has delivered a range of community benefits including:

- Travel time savings for motorists using the intersection, particularly during peak periods.
- Reduced queue lengths and traffic delays due to a better flow of traffic through the intersection.
- Improved road safety for all road users.
- Improved access and mobility for pedestrians.
