## Night and weekend work at Medlow Bath from 13 February

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the replacement of a rail building located near Station Street and recently started early preparation work for the pedestrian bridge near Railway Parade.

Most of the of the work is occurring on weekdays between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Friday**, however, crews will make use of an upcoming railway shutdown to carry out work within the railway corridor on the weekend and some nights.

Weekend work will take place on Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 February 2023 from **6am** to **6pm**, weather permitting near Station Street and Railway. Refer to the map for more information.

Nightwork will take place from Monday 13 to Wednesday 15 February from **7pm** to **5am** near Station Street as part of the rail building replacement work.

Work on the railway building replacement is expected to be completed in late **2023** at which time construction on the pedestrian bridge will start, weather permitting.

## How will the work affect you?

The use of the plant and machinery will generate some low-level noise, however, this work will be carried out during the day to minimise impact to the community. Machinery will be turned off when not in use.

During night work, lights will be directed to the work area and the noisiest activities will be completed by midnight. We will make every effort to minimise noise and will continue to keep you informed as the project progresses.

## Traffic changes

There will be an increase in plant and truck movements on Station Street and Railway Parade during the work. Traffic control will be in place along the Great Western Highway and Railway Parade to ensure safety of workers and motorists. A 250 metre section of the shoulder along the western side of the Great Western Highway north of Station Street will be closed during this time. A reduced speed limit of 40 km and traffic controllers will be in place.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.
