


Centre median construction and 24/7 asphalt works on the Great Western Highway at Raglan from 5 November

Kelso to Raglan Upgrade

October 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing \$73 million to upgrade the Great Western Highway between Kelso and Raglan near Bathurst.

Transport for NSW and our contractors will carry out the work which includes the construction of a centre median and asphalting and linemarking the entire length of the project.

What work are we doing?

Work will include construction of the centre median between Eugenie Street and Napoleon Street.

We will also commence 24-hour asphalting works to lay the final layer of asphalt across the entire length of the project.

We have included a map to show the locations of the work.

When and where we'll be working

To construct the centre median, we will be working during the day from Tuesday 31 October and we expect to complete the work in two weeks, weather permitting.

We will be working at various locations between Eugenie Street and Napoleon Street

To complete the final asphalt layer, we will be working 24hours, seven days a week from Sunday 5 November and we expect to complete the work in two weeks, weather permitting.

The asphalt work plan is (weather permitting):

5 – 8 November – eastern end of the project to PJ Moodie Memorial Drive

8 – 15 November – Ashworth Drive to Napoleon Street

14 – 19 November – Eugenie Street to Napoleon Street

If the work is not completed by 19 November, the work will continue for the following week.

Following the completion of asphalt, line marking will take place across the entire project length.

How will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Reduced speed limits to 40km/h

Managing our impacts


We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and completing noisier activities earlier in the night
- Directing lighting away from residences where possible
- Maintaining access for residents

Traffic impacts

- Intermittent stopping.
- Reduced speed limits of 40km/h
- Allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic controllers and slow down on approach.
