

# Infrastructure upgrade at Kembla Grange Station

## Community notification

September 2023

The More Trains, More Services program is delivering platform extensions and asset upgrades between Sydney's CBD and the South Coast.

### What work are we doing?

In September work includes:

- installing cable routes
- replacing overhead wiring
- installing cables and cable containment.

### Weekend work

Weekend work will be carried out between **6pm Friday 8 September** and **7am Monday 11 September 2023**.

For the safety of staff and customers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

### Working hours

Aside from weekend work mentioned above, work will take place during standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

### Traffic changes

We will be temporarily closing West Dapto Road at the level crossing to complete work safely between **9pm Friday 8 September** and **11pm Sunday 10 September**.

Traffic control and detours will be in place. We will try to minimise impacts as much as possible by turning off machinery and equipment when not in use and using targeted lighting to reduce light spill.

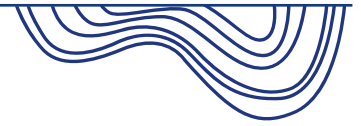
