King Georges Road Upgrade

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading King Georges Road between Stoney Creek Road, Beverly Hills and Forest Road, Hurstville to improve safety, reduce congestion and improve journey times for road users.

What work are we doing?

- Earthworks in the north and southbound verge
- Utility relocation and installation
- Stormwater drainage works
- Property adjustments
- Realignment of Sydney Water culvert at Clarence Street
- Pavement construction, asphaltting, line marking, kerb and gutter construction.

Traffic changes on King Georges Road

From **Thursday 30 November**, there will be traffic changes on King Georges Road.

Forest Road to Dudley Street traffic switch

- North and southbound lanes will be shifted to the western side of King Georges Road
- Traffic barriers will be installed on the eastern side of King Georges Road.

George Street to Warwick Street traffic switch

- North and southbound lanes will be shifted to the eastern side of King Georges Road
- Traffic barriers will be installed on the western side of King Georges Road.

When and where we'll be working

From **November 2023 to February 2024**, our night work hours will be between **8pm and 5am** from **Sunday to Friday**. We will work a maximum of five nights per week. Our day work hours will be from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**, weather and site conditions permitting.

No work will take place on Sundays during the day, or on public holidays, without prior notification.

Our holiday shutdown period will be from Monday 25 December 2023 to Sunday 7 January 2024.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Reduced speed limits
- Pedestrian detours
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Installing noise blankets, where possible
- Reducing noise, where possible
- Completing noisier activities like saw-cutting and jack-hammering by midnight, where possible.
