

Temporary changes to driveway access

King Georges Road Upgrade

December 2023







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW Governments are upgrading King Georges Road between Stoney Creek Road, Beverly Hills and Forest Road, Hurstville to improve safety, reduce congestion and improve journey times for road users.

What work are we doing?

From Wednesday 10 January to Sunday 31 January 2024, concrete barriers will be placed along King Georges Road. Vehicle access to properties between 692 and 616, and between 611 and 569 King Georges Road will temporarily change for up to 6 months, weather and site conditions permitting.

Temporary driveway restrictions may be in place during construction. Affected residents will be notified prior.

Residential vehicle entry and exit points between 692 and 616 King Georges Road will be located at:

- 692 King Georges Road (exit only)
- 666-668 King Georges Road (entry and exit)
- 636-640 King Georges Road (entry and exit)
- 616 King Georges Road (entry only).

Residential vehicle entry and exit points between 611 and 569 King Georges Road will be located at:

- 611 King Georges Road (entry only)
- 597 King Georges Road (entry and exit)
- 591-595 King Georges Road (entry and exit)
- 569 King Georges Road (exit only).

All residential entry and exits points will be left In and left out only. No right turns will be permitted. Please see Figure 1 and Figure 2 over the page.

When and where we'll be working

Our night work hours will be between **8pm and 6am** from **Sunday to Friday**. We will work a maximum of five nights per week.

Our day work hours will be from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**,
weather and site conditions permitting.

No work will take place on Sundays during the day, or on public holidays, without prior notification.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Traffic controllers, workers and vehicles
- Reduced speed limits in shared work areas
- Pedestrian detours
- Noise from machinery and equipment.
- Increased wayfinding signage.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing noise and installing noise blankets, where possible
- Completing noisier activities like saw-cutting and jackhammering by midnight.
