Kingsgrove to Beverly Hills

Project update | April – June 2022

More Trains, More Services

As part of the More Trains, More Services program, we are removing redundant track and infrastructure from the rail corridor between Beverly Hills and Kingsgrove stations. This work will facilitate improved movement and management of train services and remove unnecessary maintenance costs.

What's next between Kingsgrove to Beverly Hills?

Between April and June, our work between Kingsgrove and Beverly Hills will involve signalling activities where we are required to remove redundant cables and install new overhead wiring structures. Track work will involve the removal of old rail and installation of new rail infrastructure.

Night work

Some upcoming activities are required to take place outside of standard construction hours between Friday **29 April** and Monday **2 May**. This work has been scheduled to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

Temporary parking and traffic changes

From **5pm Tuesday 26 April** until **5pm Friday 6 May**, we will require the use of 60 car parking spaces for the safe delivery of machinery and equipment between Beverly Hills and Kingsgrove stations.

We will temporarily reserve 30 spaces off Tooronga Terrace and 30 spaces off Morgan Street, as indicated in the image below.

Traffic control will be in place to minimise disruptions to motorists and signage will be installed in advance to notify of these changes.

Construction hours

From **1 April 2022**, standard construction hours will revert to **7am-6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am-1pm on Saturdays**.
