The intersection of Lane Cove and Waterloo Road at Macquarie Park is being upgraded

The intersection is being upgraded to accommodate the area's rapid growth as a residential, commercial, and shopping district.

The improvements aim to enhance bus services, alleviate congestion, and optimize traffic flow and safety for all road users.

This long-term project aims to ensure the reliability and efficiency of transportation while supporting future development of the area.

What work are we doing?

The project will:

- Provide a new 170 metre dedicated bus only right turn lane from Waterloo Road onto Lane Cove Road south
- Provide a new 70 metre westbound through lane on Waterloo Road
- Extend the northbound left hand turn slip lane from Lane Cove Road onto Waterloo Road
- Extend the left turn lane from Waterloo Road eastbound onto Lane Cove Road.

What has been completed?

We relocated utilities into a new purpose built corridor on the Northern side of Waterloo Road. The carpark outside 33 Waterloo is now reopened, and underground services were implemented across Lane Cove Road without disruptions to the road.

What work is upcoming?

Work planned to take place over the next few months includes:

- Continuation of utility relocation for electricity, street lighting, water, gas, telecommunications, and stormwater
- Begin footpath and driveway construction on the Northern side of Waterloo Road
- Commencing construction of a small retaining wall at 43 Waterloo Road
- Road widening on the Northern side of Waterloo Road

When and where we'll be working

- From **2 July to 29 September**, we will work up to five-night shifts per week, from 8pm to 5am.
- Deliveries and minor works will be conducted at our site on the western end of Waterloo Road. Our day work hours are **Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm** and on **Saturdays from 8am to 1pm**.
- There will be no work on public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

As works continue, several changes will affect roads and footpaths. There will be new traffic changes and some noise from nearby constructions.



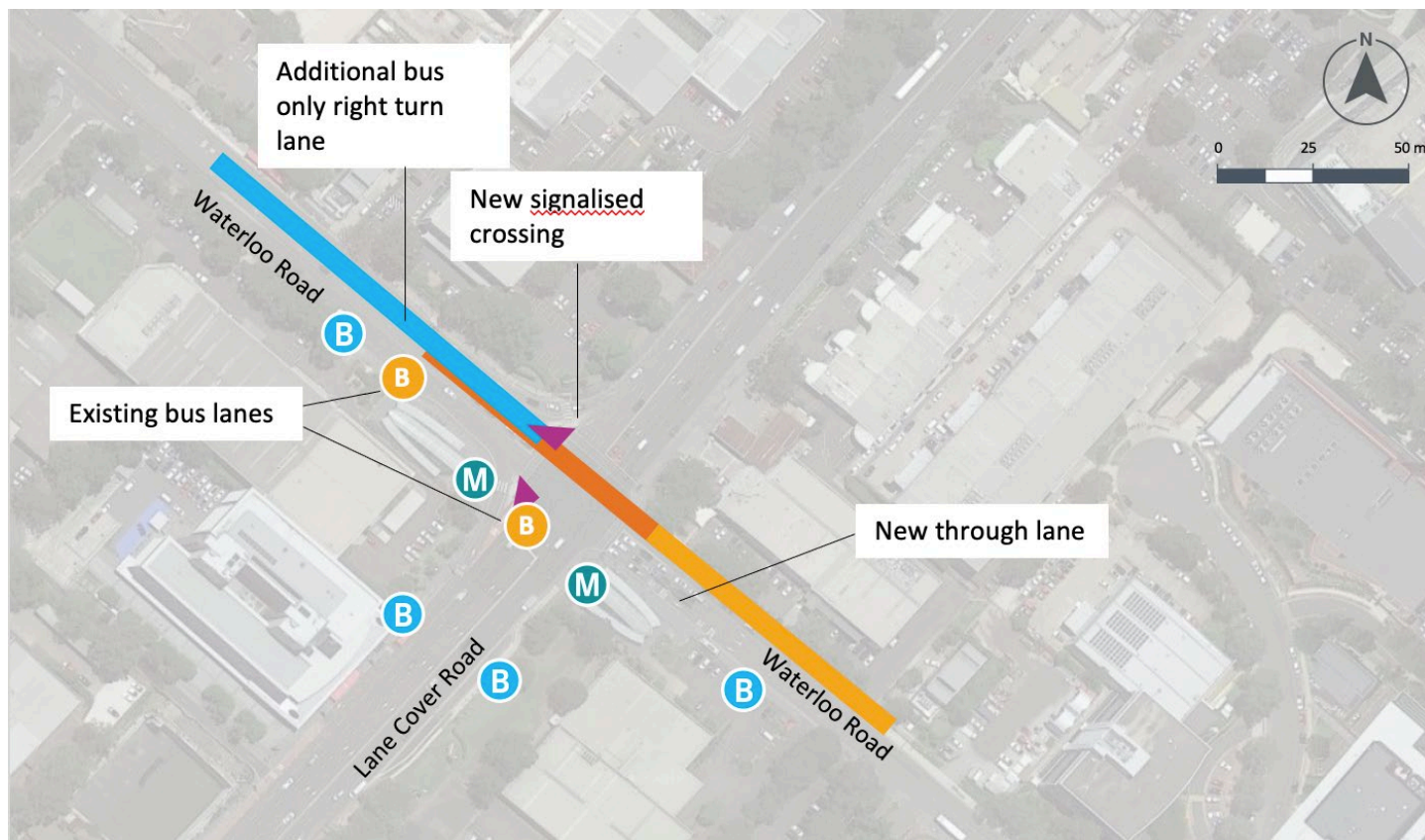
You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Reduced speed limits
- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Some footpath restrictions
- Adjustments to road configurations

Managing our effects

We understand that our work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen the disturbance, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
