


Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road Intersection, Macquarie Park

Transport for NSW is continuing work to upgrade the intersection at Lane Cove and Waterloo Roads, Macquarie Park.

This will improve bus travel through the intersection, reduce congestion and improve travel times.

What have we done so far?

In the past three months, we have:

- relocated and connected two water mains along Waterloo Road
- installed stormwater drains on 43 Waterloo Road and 33 Waterloo Road
- relocated a gas main, telecommunication assets including cables and pits and street lighting around the intersection of Lane Cove Road and Waterloo Road

Utility work

What work is being done underground?

Our utility relocation work ensures that the power, water, gas, telecommunication services and stormwater drains are relocated before we widen Waterloo Road.

During our time on the site, you may have noticed that most of our work has been under the roadway and footpath, and it can be difficult to see any physical progress.

We have relocated approximately:

Water main pipes: 120 metres

Street lighting conduits: 1,000 metres

Electrical conduits: 300 metres

Gas mains pipes: 80 metres

Telecommunications: 4,000 metres

Stormwater drains: 60 metres.


Our work schedule

Between December 2023 and February 2024 to continue the work safely and lessen traffic disruption, our crews will continue night work between **8pm to 5am**, excluding Friday and Saturday nights, unless otherwise notified.

Some day work will occur along the eastbound and westbound lane of Waterloo Road. Day work hours are **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **8am to 1pm** Saturdays. There will be no work on public holidays.

What's next?

Key activities planned for December 2023 to February 2024 include:

- connecting the final section of the water pipe to the Sydney Water system on Waterloo Road between Harvest Street and Lane Cove Road
- completing telecommunications relocations along Waterloo Road
- temporary line marking and installing safety barriers along the eastbound and westbound lane of Waterloo Road
- temporary footpaths to provide pedestrian access for civil works to construct the road pavement to widen Waterloo Road
- constructing new road pavement, footpaths, driveways, kerb, and gutters on the northern and southern end of Waterloo Road.

Managing our work

Our work can be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance on the local community and motorists in the area.

Traffic changes

Temporary footpath and lane closures will be in place, so the work zone is safe. Our work may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits, follow signs, and traffic controllers' directions.

Holiday season shutdown

While the holiday season is upon us, to give the community and our workers a break, the team will take a break from work from **Saturday 23**December 2023 and will resume work on Monday 8 January 2024.
