Out of hours work in Kemp's Creek and Cecil Park – April 2023

What are we doing?

Transport for NSW will continue night work for **17 night shifts** between **Saturday 1 April** and **Saturday 29 April 2023** along Elizabeth Drive, Clifton Avenue, Salisbury Avenue, Mamre Road, Range Road and Duff Road in Kemp's Creek and Cecil Park.

During this period, we will:

- install new communications, power and water mains
- deliver imported earthworks material to the construction site via Elizabeth Drive, Mamre Road, Range Road and Clifton Avenue
- carry out bridge piling works at Elizabeth Drive
- deliver, use and remove oversized equipment when needed
- deliver oversize precast concrete girders
- repair, maintain and install road pavement as required
- landscape maintenance and grass cutting.

These works need to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and road users and to minimise traffic disruption.

We will also start low impact earthwork activities from **6am, Monday to Saturday** across the project beginning **Saturday 1 April 2023**. Occasionally, we may need to start from **5am** or finish after **6pm, Monday to Saturdays** to do concrete pours for bridge works as the quality of concrete can be impacted if activities are not continuous, they occur during hot, cold or windy conditions.

Our work schedules

Our night work hours are between **6pm** and **7am, Monday to Friday**. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week, in the same location.

Normal work hours are between **7am** and **6pm, Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays**. There will be no work on public holidays.

What equipment will be used?

During the work we may use excavators, compactors, graders, scrapers, piling equipment, concreting equipment, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, cranes, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, milling machines, asphalt pavers, bobcats and lighting towers.

How will this work affect you?

During our work you may see increased activities in the area. The work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities earlier in the night before **midnight**, where possible, and turning off equipment and machinery when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone and traffic are safe while the equipment is used, delivered and removed.
