

Work on Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road, Cecil Road, Cecil Park and the M7 Motorway

M7-M12 Integration Project

September 2023



We acknowledge the Dharug people of the Darug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The M7-M12 Integration Project will support future development growth in Western Sydney by improving travel times and congestion. Once complete, the project will provide direct access to commercial and residential hubs, and the new Western Sydney International Airport.

What work are we doing?

We plan to carry out work on Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road, Cecil Road and at Cecil Park between **Friday 1 September** and **Saturday 30 September 2023**, weather permitting.

This work includes:

- investigations and surveys
- environmental investigations and assessments relating to flora and fauna, soil and water
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- identifying and flagging any environmentally sensitive areas
- utilities investigation, installation and relocation
- inspecting roads, including condition surveys and traffic assessments
- vegetation and tree clearing
- delivery and storage of materials
- earthworks in preparation for construction activities
- establishing site compounds and temporary work zones including installing barriers, fencing, offices, site sheds and services

- building a temporary retaining wall along the southern side of Elizabeth Drive east of the M7 Motorway
- installing barriers along Elizabeth Drive between Duff Road and Windsor Road, and Cecil Road between Elizabeth Drive and Washington Way. There will be no access to the southern side of Elizabeth Drive via the cycleway.

Work along the M7 Motorway between the M5/M7 intersection and Richmond Road will include site investigations such as non-destructive digging and surveys.

Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays**. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

Our night work hours are between **6pm** and **7am**, **Monday** to **Saturday morning**. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week or ten nights in a month, in the same location where the predicted construction noise levels will exceed the approved noise management levels.

Help us plan for future night work

For the safety of our workers, pedestrians and travelling public, some work will need to be completed at night. Some activities close to residential areas may be noisy. Impacted residents will be notified separately. We invite your feedback on appropriate respite periods or mitigation measures that may be required for your specific circumstances.



What equipment will be used?

During the work we may use vacuum excavation trucks, road saws, specialised ground penetrating equipment, cranes and lifting equipment, elevated work platforms, delivery trucks, chainsaws, excavators, mulchers, compactors, watercarts, profiler, sweepers, light vehicles/towers and portable sheds, saws, tipper trucks, dozers, slashers, vibratory rollers, pump and generators, line marking truck, articulated dump trucks, semi-trailers and dog trailers, hand tools, power tools and traffic control.

What will this mean for you?

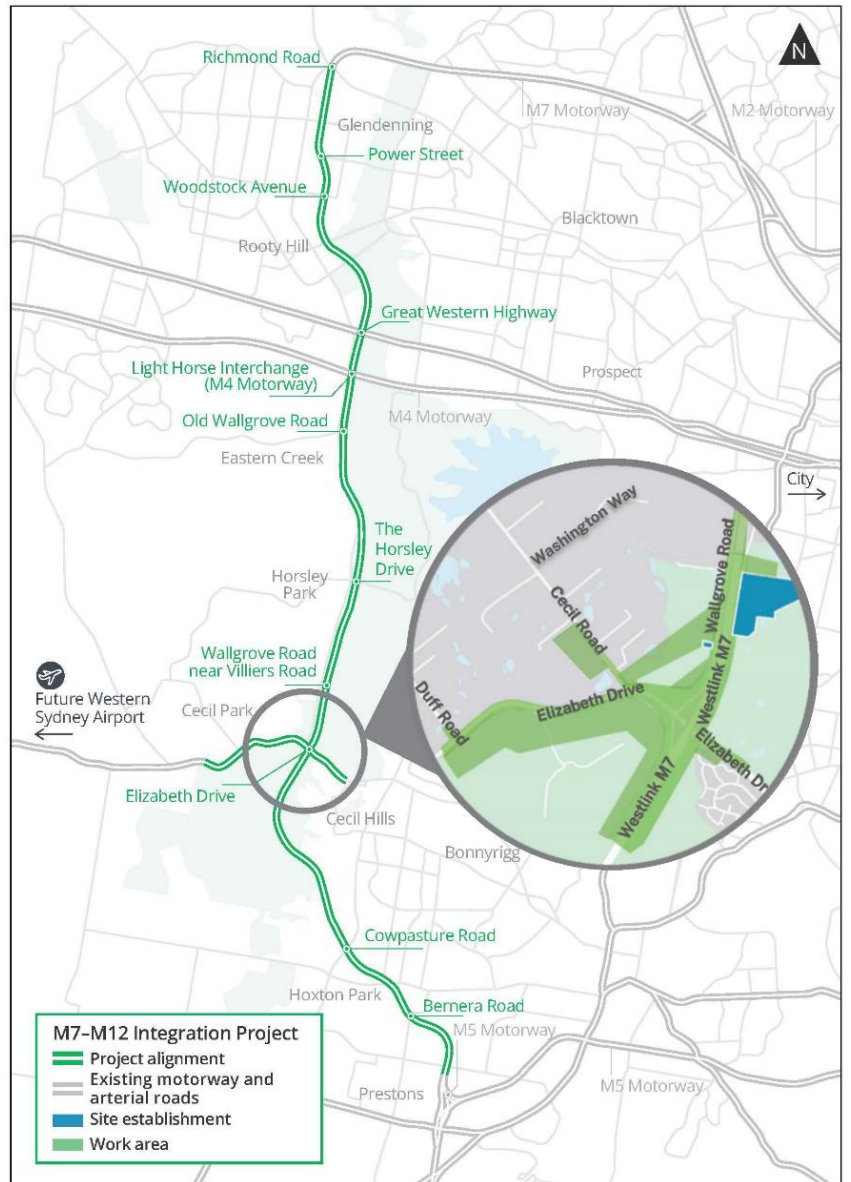
Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained. There may be temporary impacts to traffic and reduced speed limits in our work zone along Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road and Cecil Road, as well as the M7 Motorway between the M5 and Richmond Road. There will be periodic width restrictions along sections of the M7 shared user path. Signage will be installed to advise cyclists and pedestrians of changes.

Managing our impacts

During our work you will also see an increase in activity in the area as workers move around the site. We will take every possible step to minimise noise, such as scheduling any noisy work earlier in the evening during night work, switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
