More Trains, More Services

October 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure near Hurstville Station to allow trains to cross over from one track to another. This will mean that local services travelling away from the city can end their journey at Hurstville Station on Platform 4 and then start their return service to the city from Platform 3.

What work are we doing?

Between late 2020 and mid-2022, we installed new assets inside the rail corridor.

In October 2023, we will begin to prepare these assets for operational use. We will also carry out track work.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

For safety reasons, some work will take place outside of these hours between **9pm Friday 6 October** and **4am Monday 9 October 2023** when no trains will be running.

We will be working inside the rail corridor and the compounds on Forest Road as shown overleaf. The compounds will be used for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, worker briefings, amenities and parking.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic control on Forest Road to manage vehicles accessing the compounds
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand our work may cause disruption for the community. We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and follow strict environmental conditions relating to light spill, noise, vibration and dust management.


There's a lot happening
