More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network. In order to improve train services for customers on the south coast, platform extensions and asset upgrades are required at a number of stations along the T4 Illawarra Line.

What's happening?

We will be completing work in and around the rail corridor at Albion Park, Kembla Grange and Spring Hill to support the introduction of the new 10-car Mariyung fleet which will provide a new level of comfort and convenience for intercity customers.

Between April and June 2022, we will be undertaking preliminary site investigations, geotechnical assessments and survey work to further inform the technical design for the project. We will continue to work with local communities and keep you informed about construction activities in your area.

Upcoming night work

Some of these activities are required to be carried outside of standard construction hours. These works will be carried out between **6pm Friday 8 April and 7am Sunday 11 April 2022**. This work has been scheduled to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

New Mariyung Fleet

The introduction of a new 55-train fleet with 554 new carriages will provide improved customer safety, accessibility, and comfort. This fleet has been called 'Mariyung', the Durug word for Emu, in acknowledgement of the local Aboriginal culture.
