

Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade – Seven Hills

More Trains, More Services

July - August 2023

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers. It means customers can expect more frequent train services, with less wait times, less crowding on a simpler and more reliable network.

This project will upgrade the overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor to improve train movements through Seven Hills Station.

What work are we doing?

Investigation work was carried out between November 2022 and May 2023 to assist with early planning and design.

Main construction will start in July 2023 and will involve the following work inside the rail corridor:

- reinstatement of previously excavated areas
- adjustments to existing overhead wiring infrastructure
- installation of new footings that will serve as the foundation for new overhead wiring infrastructure. This will involve excavation and concreting work.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor.

Temporary site compounds will be established on Hartley Road and inside the commuter carpark off Boomerang Place. The compounds will be used for storage of equipment and materials, worker parking and pre-start work meetings.

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours from 10pm Friday 21 July to 2am Monday 24 July 2023.

Why we work outside of standard construction hours

The work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete the activities safely.

Temporary parking changes

From Wednesday 19 July to Monday 24 July 2023 there will be temporary parking changes inside the commuter carpark off Boomerang Place. This is to facilitate deliveries and enable construction activities. Signage will be installed to indicate where the temporary parking changes will be in effect.

What will this mean for you?

In addition to the temporary parking changes, you may notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles
- deliveries of machinery and equipment
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- traffic control.
