

# Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade – Westmead

## More Trains, More Services

July - August 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Burramattagal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers. It means customers can expect more frequent train services, with less wait times, less crowding on a simpler and more reliable network.

This project will upgrade the overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor to improve train movements through Westmead Station.

### What work are we doing?

Investigation work was carried out between March and May 2023 to assist with early planning and design.

Main construction will start in July 2023 and will involve work to prolong the life of existing overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor. This work is also known as 'structure strengthening'.

## When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor as shown on the map overleaf.

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours from 10pm Friday 21 July to 2am Monday 24 July 2023.

## Why we work outside of standard construction hours

The work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete the activities safely.

#### Temporary parking changes

From Thursday 20 July to Monday 24 July 2023 there will be a loss of up to six parking spaces near the rail access gate on Alexandra Avenue. This is to facilitate deliveries and enable construction activities.

## What will this mean for you?

In addition to the temporary parking changes on Alexandra Avenue, you may notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles
- deliveries of machinery and equipment
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- traffic control.

## Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
