

# More Trains, More Services

## Port Kembla North



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In order to improve train services for customers on the south coast, platform extensions and asset upgrades are required at a number of stations along this line. This important work will support the introduction of new fleet of longer trains called 'Mariyung', the Darug word for Emu, in acknowledgement of local Aboriginal culture.

The 55-train fleet with 554 new carriages will offer improved safety, accessibility, comfort and modern features for customers who make almost 45 million journeys a year on the electrified intercity network.

We have been preparing Port Kembla Station for platform extension work, which is scheduled in the coming months.

In November, we will also start investigation activities at Port Kembla North Station in preparation for the installation of new signalling equipment and improved station safety features including closed circuit television, lighting and public address systems. These activities will be carried out during standard construction hours, between **7am-6pm**.

Our work over the next couple of months will include underground service investigations and installation of a 'frog fence' to protect the Green and Golden Bell Frog habitat during construction activities next year.
