

# More Trains, More Services

## Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration Project – Central



### What are we doing at Central?

We're upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to support the introduction of the new fleet of trains operating on the South Coast Line which will access platforms 1 to 14 at Central Station.

### What has happened lately?

In October we installed two new track crossovers. We also installed electrical and signalling infrastructure, and constructed a cable route.

### What's planned next?

In December 2021 and January 2022 we will assemble track components inside our site compound at Mortuary Station. We will also upgrade, install and commission new electrical, signalling and overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor.

### When will construction take place?

To support the construction industry through the COVID-19 pandemic, the NSW Government has extended an amendment to the legislation regarding standard day-time construction hours.

This amendment enables activities to be carried out between **7am and 6pm Monday to Sunday and public holidays**.

Some construction work will take place outside of these hours from:

- **Monday 27 December from 7am to 7pm (public holiday)**
- **10pm Saturday 1 January through to 2am Tuesday 4 January**
- **5am Saturday 8 January through to 10pm Sunday 9 January**

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our team to complete essential activities safely.

Work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

The project team would like to thank you for your patience during our works throughout 2021 and we wish you and your family a safe and happy holiday season.



### Where will work take place?

The above map shows the project site compound located at Mortuary Station and the work area inside the rail corridor.

The project team will utilise the site compound to assemble track components and for storage of materials and equipment, pre-start work meetings and worker parking.

### When will night-time deliveries take place?

Some oversized deliveries and pick up of rail infrastructure will happen at night to minimise disruption to traffic and to improve safety for our workers and the community:

- **Tuesday 7 December between 2am and 8am**
- **Sunday 26 December between 9pm and 7am**

### How are we staying safe?

We continue to deliver projects across NSW while ensuring the safety of all staff and the community.

In line with current Australian Government guidelines around slowing the spread of COVID-19 the site will have a dedicated COVID Marshall to ensure all people entering the site are safe to do so (as per current NSW Health guidelines) and all necessary hygiene practices will be observed.
