Two rail infrastructure upgrade projects are currently being delivered in your area as part of the More Trains, More Services program, including:

- Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration project
- Newtown to Redfern Signalling Upgrade project.

What work are we doing?

In April and May we'll carry out the following work inside the rail corridor:

- installation and commissioning of new overhead wiring, signalling and electrical infrastructure
- work to remove a redundant track crossover (rail infrastructure that allows trains to change tracks) and replace it with straight tracks
- installation of drainage.

You may also notice deliveries of materials and equipment to our work areas and compounds. The majority of deliveries will be scheduled during the day, however some deliveries will be required at night during scheduled trackwork periods.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am** and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Work will take place inside the rail corridor as shown overleaf. The site compounds near Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard and off Railway Parade/Henderson Road will be used for storage of equipment and materials, worker parking and pre-start work meetings.

Out-of-hours work

Some work will take place outside of standard construction hours from:

- 10pm Friday 31 March to 2am Monday 3 April
- 10pm Thursday 6 April to 2am Tuesday 11 April
- 10pm Friday 21 April to 2am Monday 24 April
- 10pm Friday 28 April to 2am Monday 1 May
- 10pm Friday 12 May to 2am Monday 15 May
- 10pm Friday 19 May to 2am Monday 22 May

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling work outside of standard construction hours enables us to complete essential work safely.

Temporary parking changes

Up to **15 parking spaces** will be temporarily reserved on **Railway Parade**, Erskineville and **Henderson Road**, Eveleigh from:

- 2pm Thursday 6 April to 2am Tuesday 11 April
- 2pm Friday 21 April to 2am Monday 24 April
- 2pm Friday 12 May to 2am Monday 16 May

This is to enable construction activities during scheduled trackwork periods.

We have marked a larger area on the map overleaf than is required in case some parking spaces are already taken but will reserve no more than 15 spaces in total.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your patience.
