What are we doing?

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to simplify and modernise the rail network so that customers can expect more frequent train services in the future.

What's been happening?

Due to external factors outside our control, we have been unable to carry out work inside the rail corridor in recent months.

We hope to recommence construction work in your area soon and will let you know in advance of this occurring.

What's planned next?

In November you may notice deliveries of materials and equipment to our compounds near Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard and off Railway Parade as shown below.

When will the deliveries take place?

We are scheduling the majority of deliveries during standard construction hours: **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.**

Some of the deliveries to the compound near Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard are scheduled to occur at night between:

- 6pm and 7am Tuesday 22 November
- 6pm and 7am Wednesday 23 November

These out-of-hours deliveries will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running.

We thank you for your patience and will make every effort to minimise disruption to nearby residents.
