

More Trains, More Services

Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration Project



We're upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to simplify and modernise the rail network so that customers can expect more frequent train services in the future.

What happened in March?

During March, we carried out signalling work, installation of overhead wiring structures and drainage work on track.

What's planned next?

Next month, we will carry out the following activities:

- signalling works
- pre-assembling track in the laydown area
- delivery of oversized rail infrastructure and materials from Erskineville to our project site laydown area at Mortuary Station.

Construction will primarily take place during standard construction hours from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Are there activities planned outside of standard construction hours?

To minimise disruption to customers, and to improve the safety of workers and the community, oversized deliveries of rail infrastructure will take place on the following evenings from 6pm to 7am:

- Wednesday 31 March and Thursday 1 April

Some construction work will also be completed outside of standard construction hours. This work is taking place during a scheduled trackwork period when no trains will be running.

The work will occur from **10pm, Friday 2 April to 5am, Monday 5 April.**



Undertaking this construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our construction team to complete essential activities safely inside the rail corridor.

Will alternative transport services be running during scheduled track work weekends?

Where will work take place?

The above map shows the project area inside the rail corridor in Eveleigh including both site compounds. The site access points are on Swanson Street and Railway Parade.
