Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration Project – Erskineville Transport for NSW | July 2022

What are we doing?

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to simplify and modernise the rail network so that customers can expect more frequent train services in the future.

What's been happening?

In June we carried out electrical work inside the rail corridor and received deliveries of equipment and materials at the site compound near Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard.

What's planned next?

In July we will install overhead wiring, signalling and electrical infrastructure inside the rail corridor. We will also feed cables through the recently installed galvanised steel trough on Burren Street to support signalling infrastructure inside the rail corridor.

You may notice deliveries of materials and equipment to our compounds near Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard and off Railway Parade as shown overleaf. The majority of deliveries will be scheduled during the day, however some deliveries will be required at night during scheduled trackwork periods.

When will work take place?

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Some work and deliveries will take place outside of these hours:

- Between 2am Saturday 2 July through to 2am Monday 4 July
- Between 2am Saturday 9 July through to 2am Monday 11 July
- Between 2am Saturday 23 July through to 2am Monday 25 July

The work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete essential work safely.

There is a possibility that some of our planned work may be postponed or cancelled. Where will work take place?

The above map shows the work areas inside the rail corridor and our site compounds. The site access points are on Railway Parade, Erskineville Road and Buren Street.

The project team will continue to utilise the site compounds for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, offices, pre-start work meetings and worker parking.

How do we consider the community?

The project team understands construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
