Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration Project – Erskineville

What are we doing?

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to simplify and modernise the rail network so that customers can expect more frequent train services in the future.

What's been happening?

In May we installed a new galvanised steel trough on Sydney Trains land at the end of Burren Street as shown in the photo below. We also carried out electrical work inside the rail corridor.

What's planned next?

In June we will continue to install electrical infrastructure inside the rail corridor.

You may also notice deliveries of materials and equipment to our compound at Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard. The majority of deliveries will be scheduled during the day, however some deliveries will be required at night during scheduled trackwork periods.

When will work take place?

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.**

Some work and deliveries will take place outside of these hours:

- **Between 2am Saturday 11 June through to 2am Tuesday 14 June**
- **Between 2am Saturday 25 June through to 2am Monday 27 June**

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete essential activities safely.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.



Work to install a new galvanised steel trough on Sydney Trains land at the end of Burren Street took place in May 2022. In the coming months we will feed cables through the trough to support new signalling infrastructure inside the rail corridor.



Where will work take place?

The above map shows the work areas inside the rail corridor and our site compounds. The site access points are on Railway Parade and Erskineville Road.

The project team will continue to utilise the site compounds for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, offices, pre-start work meetings and worker parking.

How do we consider the community?

The project team understands construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

How are we staying safe?

We continue to deliver projects across NSW while ensuring the safety of all staff and the community. All work will be carry out in line with current Australian Government guidelines around slowing the spread of COVID-19.
