

Drainage upgrade work at Eveleigh

Sydney Terminal Area Reconfiguration Project More Trains, More Services

January to April 2023

Transport for NSW pays respect to Elders past and present, and recognises and celebrates the diversity of Aboriginal peoples and their ongoing cultures and connections to the lands and waters of NSW.

We're upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to support the introduction of the new fleet of trains operating on the South Coast Line. This includes upgrading the drainage system within the rail corridor at Eveleigh to prevent future flooding and improve reliability across the network.

What work are we doing?

Pump station construction

From **Monday 30 January 2023** we will continue construction of a new pump station inside the Eveleigh Maintenance Centre (EMC). This work is expected to take a further **three months** to complete and will take place during standard construction hours.

Once construction is complete, the project team will return to EMC later in the year to commission the new pump station. We will keep you updated as our work progresses.

Drainage pipe installation

From **Friday 10 March 2023** we will commence work to install new drainage pipes beneath 270 metres of track inside the rail corridor. The work will involve removing sections of track, installing new drainage pipes and reinstating track.

To complete the work safely, this will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running.

The work is expected to take **around ten weekends** to complete, with three weekends of work planned in March and April.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

Work inside the rail corridor will take place outside these hours from:

- **10pm Friday 10 March through to 2am Monday 13 March 2023**
- **10pm Thursday 6 April through to 2am Tuesday 11 April 2023**
- **10pm Friday 21 April through to 2am Monday 24 April 2023.**

Deliveries

As part of the upcoming work there will be deliveries of equipment, machinery and materials.

The majority of deliveries will be scheduled during the day, however some deliveries will be required to take place out-of-hours:

- An oversized delivery for the new pump station will take place on Locomotive Street between **11pm Thursday 16 February and 7am Friday 17 February 2023**
- In connection with work inside the rail corridor, deliveries will take place during the scheduled trackwork periods in March and April as outlined above.

The truck routes to and from our work areas are shown on the map overleaf.



Where we'll be working

The above map shows the work areas inside the rail corridor and our site compounds. The project team will utilise the site compounds for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, offices, pre-start work meetings and worker parking.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

We're going paperless

We are committed to integrating sustainable practices into our projects and reducing environmental impacts.

Soon we will no longer be distributing paper notifications to residents on this project unless requested. Instead, we will be providing construction updates via email.
