



## More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network. In order to improve train services for customers on the south coast, platform extensions and asset upgrades are required at a number of stations along the T4 Illawarra Line.

### What is happening at Spring Hill and Kembla Grange?

We will be completing work in and around the rail corridor at these locations to support the introduction of the new 10-car Mariyung fleet which will provide a new level of comfort and convenience for intercity customers.

In January 2022, we will be undertaking preliminary site investigations, geotechnical assessments and survey work to further inform the technical design for the project. Investigation activities will be carried out between 6am and 6pm.

The future scope may include work such as power supply cable upgrades to operate the new fleet. We will continue to work with local communities and keep you informed about construction activities in your area.

### New Mariyung Fleet

The introduction of a new 55-train fleet with 554 new carriages will provide improved customer safety, accessibility, and comfort. This fleet has been called 'Mariyung', the Durug word for Emu, in acknowledgement of the local Aboriginal culture.
