# More Trains, More Services



#### More Trains, More Services

The More Trains, More Services program is delivering platform extensions and rail asset upgrades between Sydney's CBD and the South Coast to support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet.

#### What's been happening at Thirroul?

At Thirroul Station, we have:

- extended Platforms 1, 2 and 3 by about eight metres to accommodate the longer fleet of intercity
- trains and provide access for customers to all carriages of the train
- realigned and installed new rail track, overhead wiring, drainage, service routes and signalling equipment to facilitate an increased capacity on the network.

#### What's next?

Now platform extension work at Thirroul Station is complete, we will be moving approximately 400 metres north-east of the station where we'll continue upgrading rail infrastructure to support network improvements.

In the coming months, we will be working inside the rail corridor behind the free car park off Church Street and our scheduled activities will include:

- investigation work to identify existing infrastructure and further develop design details
- upgrading safety features and signalling infrastructure to comply with rail safety standards
- construction of a new 'turnback' to enable trains to turn back towards the direction they have come from.

#### Night work

Between January and March, some activities are required to take place outside construction hours (7am – 6pm).

This work has been scheduled to take place during a Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

Night work will be carried out between 6pm Friday 18 February and 7am Monday 21 February 2022.

#### **Construction hours**

The NSW Government has introduced new rules to support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure during COVID-19. In accordance with the Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Infrastructure Construction Work Days No. 2) Order 2020, standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Sunday, including public holidays. Note: we will not be working during the Christmas and New Year holiday period.

All work will be carried out in line with current NSW Government Public Health Orders and Restrictions, which are subject to change.

If work is postponed and expected to impact your residence, we will contact you directly to advise of any changes.
