Upcoming night work

As part of the More Trains, More Services work at Thirroul, this month we will be required to complete some construction activities outside of standard construction.

In May, weekend work is scheduled to take place between:

- **6am and 6pm Saturday 21 May**
- **6am and 10pm Sunday 22 May.**

This work will take place inside the rail corridor, approximately 500 meters north-east of Thirroul Station.

Our activities have been scheduled to take place during a Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running. This minimises disruption to our customers and enables the project team to safely carry out construction activities in the rail corridor. *For up to date information about services during these times, please visit transportnsw.info or call 131 500.*

Standard construction hours on this project are between **7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 8am-1pm on Saturdays.**

Minimising impacts

We understand that construction activities may cause disruption for the community and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts to the surrounding community
- installing noise barriers to shield residents from high impact noise activities
- conducting on-site monitoring to ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
