Thirroul Station

As part of More Trains, More Services program, we are upgrading Thirroul Station and associated rail corridor infrastructure to accommodate the Mariyung fleet.

Upcoming weekend work

During November we are completing work inside the rail corridor at Thirroul Station. This construction activity will predominantly be completed during standard construction hours however, there will be some weekend work in November. The work is scheduled to take place between **7am and 6pm** on **Saturday 19 November** and on **Sunday 20 November 2022**. Construction activities are not expected to impact residents.

New Mariyung Fleet

The introduction of a new 55-train fleet with 554 new carriages will provide improved customer safety, accessibility, and comfort. This fleet has been called 'Mariyung', the Durug word for Emu, in acknowledgement of the local Aboriginal culture.
