

Continuing day and night investigation work on Mamre Road

M4 Motorway, St Clair and James Erskine Drive, Erskine Park

June 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is planning the upgrade of Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW is continuing to carry out geotechnical investigation work along Mamre Road. Work includes:

- Preparation work (e.g. minor grass mowing)
- Drilling boreholes
- Drilling pavement cores
- Survey work

We will be using light vehicles, small excavators, a track or truck mounted drilling rig, vacuum truck, survey equipment, testing and scanning equipment and small hand tools to complete this work.

When and where we'll be working

The work will take place along Mamre Road, between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and James Erskine Drive, Erskine Park.

The work will take place from **Wednesday 5 July to Friday 8 September 2023**, weather permitting, and will be a combination of both day and night shifts. Day shift working hours will be between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**.

To ensure safety and to minimise impact on road users, some of the work must be done at night.

Night work will occur over four shifts on **Wednesday 5 July, Thursday 6 July, Monday 10 July and Tuesday 11 July**, weather permitting.

If there are unforeseen delays, **Wednesday 12 July to Wednesday 19 July** will be used as contingency shifts. Night shift working hours will be between **7pm to 5am Monday to Friday**. We will not work for more than two consecutive nights at the same location.

What will this mean for you?

Our work may be noisy, but we will do our best to minimise its impact. There will also be temporary traffic changes such as shoulder and lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the directions of traffic control and signs.

You may also notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Reduced speed limits
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

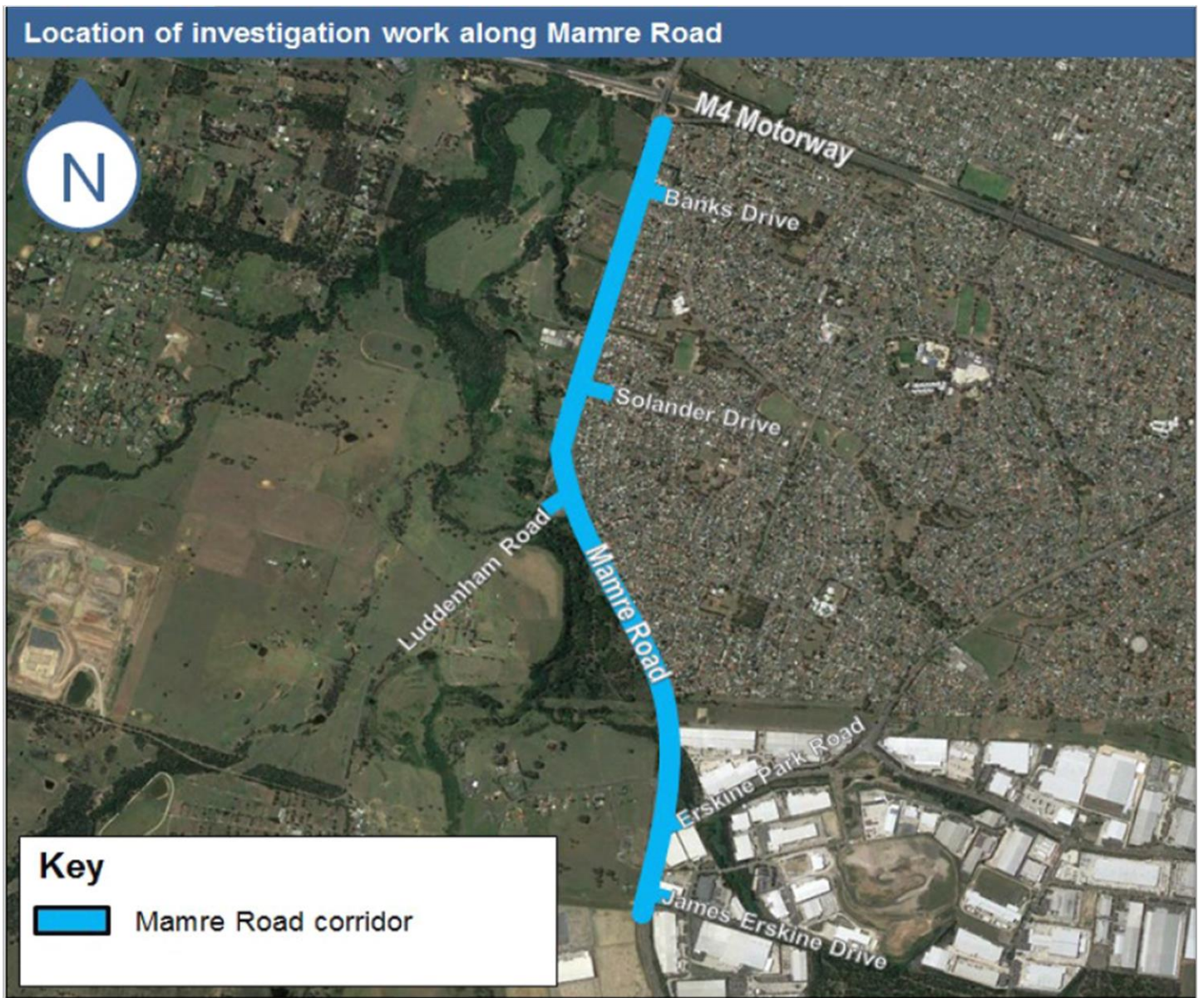
