Construction Update | March 2023

Manor Road to Foley Street

Further to our January Construction Update work is progressing well on the project, In addition to the work happening during standard construction hours, we will be working at night on Mona Vale Road between Manor Road and Foley Street from **8pm to 6am Monday 6 March to Friday 31 March 2023**, weather permitting.

Please note, in line with our environmental license, we will not work more than two consecutive nights and no more than three nights each week.

Our work will include:


- road maintenance, gate adjustments, barrier movements, line marking, and plant delivery/pick up along the project alignment
- partial closure of Mona Vale Road to lift bridge girders for the fauna overpass
- asphalting work on Samuel Street
- removing old sewer between Daydream Street and Emma Street
- connecting overhead services at the Western Early Works area inclusive of Tumburra Street (see service connection map).

- installing overhead power on Mona Vale Road
- installation of underground utilities and stormwater drainage at the intersection of Ponderosa Parade, Samuel Street and Mona Vale Road
- asphalt, kerbing, services, and median works between Daydream Street and east of Foley Street
- traffic realignment, drainage, and kerb work on Mona Vale Road near Manor Road
- construction of intersection at Ponderosa Parade, Samuel Street and Mona Vale Road.

How will our work affect you?

During this night work, machinery and equipment used may include tipper trucks, large trucks, backhoes, elevated work platforms, light vehicles, lighting towers, saw cutting machines, franna, line markers, excavators, and paving machines. This work will be noisy.

We will direct any lighting away from residential properties and turn off machinery when not in use.

Traffic changes

To minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to the workers and motorists, we need to carry out our work at night.

There will be a partial closure on Mona Vale Road during the lifting of the girders. (a separate notification will be sent out closer to the date).

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users.

This work will be weather dependent and if it does not occur on these nights, we will look to undertake the work the following week.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
