Cross-over construction on the Hume Highway at Marulan from 3 May

The Federal Stimulus Road Safety program is jointly funded by the Australian Government and NSW Government. In total, the Australian Government has committed up to \$300 million and the NSW Government a further \$108.2 million to fund the state-wide upgrades under tranche one.

What are we doing?

We will be building a series of cross-overs along the Marulan bypass to improve safety for road workers and emergency services. The cross-overs will be used to move traffic from one side of the road to the other during future road upgrade and maintenance work and during incidents and emergencies.

The work will take place at five separate locations on the Hume Highway at Marulan between Eagles Lane in the north and Munro Road in the south.

The work we will be doing will include vegetation removal, installation of drainage, minor earthworks and road resurfacing.

We will be working from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

Work will start on **Monday 3 May** and is expected to be completed by the **end of July**, weather permitting.

How will this work affect you?

During work hours the road will be reduced to one lane in each direction and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place.

On weekdays between 6pm and 7am the speed limit will be 80km/h with one lane closed in each direction.

Between 6pm Friday and 7am Monday all lanes will be open to traffic.

During work hours motorists are advised to allow up to five minutes additional travel time and follow the direction of signage and traffic control.
