

Cross-over construction on the Hume Highway at Marulan from Monday 11 October

The Federal Stimulus Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian Government and NSW Government. In total, the Australian Government has committed up to \$300 million and the NSW Government a further \$108.2 million to fund the state-wide upgrades under tranche one.

What are we doing?

We will continue building a series of cross-overs along the Marulan bypass to improve safety for road workers and emergency services. The cross-overs will be used to move traffic from one side of the road to the other during future road upgrade and maintenance work and during incidents and emergencies.

Work includes vegetation removal, installation of drainage, minor earthworks and road resurfacing.

Work will take place between Redhills Road and Eagles Lane on the Hume Highway at Marulan and will continue from **Monday 11 October for about five weeks, between 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

There will be no access to properties from the southbound lanes during the work.

Detours for impacted property owners will be in place using the existing cross overs.

Road users are advised to allow up to ten minutes additional travel time and follow the direction of signage and traffic control.

We will keep the community updated as the project progresses.
