More Trains, More Services Mascot Power Supply Upgrade Project

Transport for NSW | June 2022 update

What are we doing?

Transport for NSW is upgrading the power supply to support an increase to the number of services operating through the T8 Airport Line tunnel and support the introduction of the new fleet of trains operating along the T8 Airport Rail Line.

Mascot Power Supply Upgrade

The power supply upgrade work on Bourke Street, Mascot (between Coward and John streets) has been underway since 2021 and the project team are working hard to complete this section of work and to re-open the footpaths between Coward and John streets by October 2022. (See map overleaf).

What's happened lately?

Work at this site has been significantly impacted by wet weather since the start of the year. Despite this, the project team reached a major milestone in May 2022 when they completed the breakthrough from the retrieval shaft to the T8 Airport Line.

Upcoming extended weekend hours

To ensure the project continues to progress on schedule, an out of hours work application has been approved allowing low-impact work to be undertaken, if required, at the retrieval shaft on Bourke Street from 7am to 6pm on Saturdays and 8am to 6pm on Sundays.

These extended weekend work hours will be in place for a period of two months, **between Saturday 18 June and Sunday 21 August 2022**, and will act as a contingency if we continue to experience wet weather or encounter other unexpected delays outside our control.

How will this impact me?

Any work undertaken during the extended weekend hours would be low impact activities which are not expected to be noisy.

You may notice our workers at the retrieval shaft on Saturdays and Sundays outside of standard construction hours.

Where possible we will endeavour to minimise using these extended hours, particularly on Sundays.
