Mascot Power Supply Upgrade Project



What happened in February?

During February, we carried out site remediation work at 166 O'Riordan Street, completed some asbestos removal and installed a new driveway.

What's planned next?

During March, the project team will carry out the following work:

- piling at 166 O'Riordan Street
- utility investigations
- modifications to the road alignment and medians.

This work will enable the project team to build a new substation at 166 O'Riordan Street, and underground power supply cable route connecting the electrical substation to the train station on Bourke Street. These upgrades will create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport line in the future.

When will construction occur?

Standard construction hours on this project are **7am to 6pm** Monday to Friday, weekends and public holidays.


The project team understands construction activities may cause disruption for the community. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible including traffic control and signage for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists. We will also ensure we adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

Are there activities planned outside of standard hours?

Some work will be undertaken outside of standard construction hours on Bourke Street between Coward and John Streets. The work will occur 8pm to 6am on:

- Sunday 14 and Tuesday 16 March
- Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 March
- Monday 29 and Tuesday 30 March

We will be contacting residents directly who may be impacted by the out of hours work. This work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.



Where will work take place?

The above map shows the modification work on Bourke Street between Coward Street and John Street. This work is required to receive the tunnel boring machine when the cable route construction is nearing completion.

What else in happening in Mascot? Mascot Station Access Upgrade

Transport for NSW is building a new station entrance on the western side of Bourke Street at Mascot, in the plaza opposite the existing station entrance. This will improve the flow of customers and reduce crowding in and around the station making travel easier and more comfortable for train and road users.

During March we will continue early work to prepare for the start of construction. This includes:

- setting up temporary fencing and work areas in and around the plaza area and on Bourke Street
- continuing relocation of utilities, including water, sewer and electricity.
