Work is progressing in Mascot

Transport for NSW is continuing construction of the Mascot Station Upgrade and the Mascot Power Supply Upgrade as part of the More Trains, More Services program.

The Station Upgrade team continued with their steady progress on the new western entry station structure in January. The structure has now been excavated down to the concourse level and the concourse level slab has been poured. The team have also completed the breakthrough of the existing station wall which involved cutting and demolishing a 2.7 metre high x 3.2 metre wide hole through the one-metre thick existing station diaphragm wall. The team have also started removal of structural steel propping.

Update on project completion

Due to wet weather, there have been delays which have impacted upon the project's anticipated completion date. The current estimated project completion is mid-2023. Please note this is subject to change and weather dependent.

What's planned during February?

During February, the Station Upgrade team will continue excavating a further 1.4 metres down to the bottom of the new lift pit. The team will then complete the forming and pouring of the pits to complete the structure.

The team also plan to remove the remaining temporary propping and install the structural steel lift shaft and street level entrance canopy. Other works will include:

- scaffolding works
- demobilisation of ventilation equipment
- minor road works where required
- saw-cutting
- demolition of concrete walls
- building fit-out and installation of services within the new western entry
- defect rectification as required within the station.

As we continue excavation of the new western station entry, there may be some noise, dust and vibration impacts associated with works. We will take every possible step to minimise impacts including noise and vibration monitoring and dust suppression.

When will work take place?

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Extended Saturday hours Mascot Station Access Upgrade

As we advised in the December 2022 and January 2023 Mascot Precinct Update notification, work on the Mascot Station Upgrade had been adversely affected by the impacts of COVID on the workforce over the last 18 months, together with the extreme rain events that we have encountered. To make up lost time and the impact on our construction program, we are extending Saturday hours to 6pm. This change took effect from Saturday 23 July 2022 and will remain in place through to project completion.

Upcoming out-of-hours work **Mascot Station Upgrade**

Throughout February, there will be out-of-hours work undertaken within the station and deliveries and collection of equipment and plant for the excavation work. Specific times and dates for these activities will be notified in advance of the work occurring.

On occasion during February there will also be out-of-hours works within the existing station on the concourse level. While these works will be undertaken on the concourse level, you may notice staff and vehicles above ground.

Between 10pm Friday 17 February through to 5am Monday 20 February, the Mascot Power Supply Upgrade team will carry out electrical work inside the T8 Airport Line tunnel. The crew will access the tunnel via Mascot Station and may use the entrance to load/unload material and equipment.

Completion of all work is dependent on a number of factors including weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
