

More Trains, More Services

Working outside of standard construction hours on
Friday 30 April at Mascot Station Access Upgrade



Transport for NSW is building a new entrance at Mascot Station on the western side of Bourke Street, in the plaza opposite the existing station entrance. This will improve the flow of customers and reduce crowding in and around the station making travel easier and more comfortable for train and road users.

To support the construction industry through Coronavirus, the NSW Government have extended an amendment to the legislation regarding standard construction hours. This amendment enables activities to be carried out between **7am and 6pm on weekdays, weekends and public holidays.**

Work has been scheduled outside of standard construction hours

We have scheduled work to be completed outside of standard construction hours between **8pm Friday 30 April and 2am Saturday 1 May 2021.**

Our activities will include setting up traffic control and removing trees on both sides of Bourke Street. This landscaping will be reinstated on completion of our project.

What you will notice

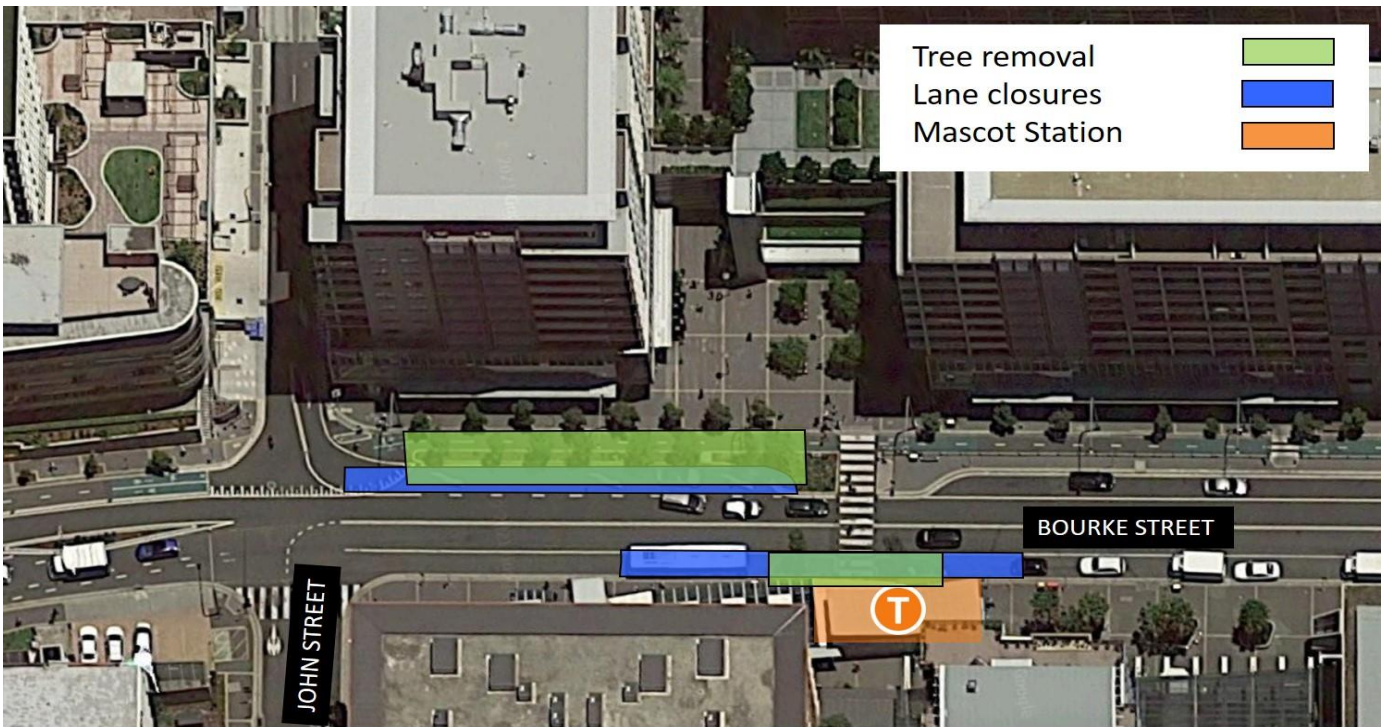
Equipment used for these activities includes an elevated work platform, electrical chainsaws, lighting towers, powered hand tools and vehicles to transport equipment and vegetation.

How will we minimise impacts?

Our work needs to be completed at night for the safety of pedestrians, our construction workers and to minimise the impact to the traffic.

We understand that our activities may cause disruption however every effort will be made to minimise impact including scheduling noisy activities at the earliest stage of the work program where possible, turning off vehicles and machinery when not in use and using noise blankets.

Completion of this work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Lane closures on Bourke Street

Traffic controllers will be on site to manage periodic lane closures on Bourke Street while our work is being completed, however a single lane in each direction will continue to be available.

A reduced speed limit of 40km/hr is in place around the project area. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured through the plaza so that our work can be completed safely. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage within the area.
