Mascot Station Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

March - April 2023

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Work continues on the Mascot Station Upgrade as part of the More Trains, More Services program.

During March and April there will be ongoing works in the station including out-of-hours works.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- electrical works
- hoarding removal
- minor road works where required
- saw-cutting
- demolition of concrete walls
- building fit-out and installation of services within the new western entry
- installation of new circuits in main switchboards within Mascot Station
- defect rectification as required within the station
- concourse tiling.

When and where we'll be working

Our construction hours are between **7am** and **6pm** Monday to Friday and **7am** and **6pm** on Saturdays.

The work will take place at the lower and upper concourse levels of Mascot Station and within the worksite on the western side of Bourke Street.

As part of the out-of-hours work there will be deliveries of equipment, machinery and materials.

To carry out the work, the construction workers will be using hand-held tools, a forklift, jackhammers, a sawcut and a generator.

Out-of-hours work

Electrical works

The team will be undertaking new circuit installation works on the main switchboards at the lower and upper concourse areas of Mascot Station over the following periods:

- From Wednesday 22 March to Friday 24 March between midnight and 7am
- From Sunday 26 March to Friday 31 March between 10pm and 7am.

Further electrical works are also planned in April. A separate notification update will be delivered to residents announcing the exact dates.

Tiling works

The team will be continuing tiling works including demolition of existing tiles and installation of new tiles at the lower concourse area of the station.

The dates and times include:

- Friday 31 March and Saturday 1 April between 8pm and 6am
- 6am Saturday 1 April through to 7am Monday 3 April
- Friday 7 April between 8pm and 7am
- Sunday 9 April and Friday 14 April between 8pm and 7am
- Sunday 16 April and Friday 21 April between 8pm and 7am
- Sunday 23 April and Friday 30 April between 8pm and 7am.

Materials and plant will be transported to and from the





concourse level for the duration of these works. The activities will be taking place during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

Gantry Crane removal

The gantry crane will be dismantled sometime in April. A separate notification update will be delivered to residents advising the dates.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

This work may be noisy however, every effort will be made to minimise noise to the community. This work is dependent on-site conditions and is subject to change. We will notify you if the dates and times of work change.

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Targeted lighting to minimise light spill.
